Adopt a Hydrant Program



At the recent Rhyll Community Association Meeting members of the Phillip Island CFA talked about their Adopt a Hydrant Program. They emphasised the importance of **fast and easy access to hydrants** in the event of a fire as **any delay** is likely to increase the intensity and damage of the fire to a house or property.



You can identify a hydrant by a white post with a red painted top in front of a property's fence line and a blue reflective marker on bitumen roads. They have asked us to ensure that the marker post is well maintained and that there is **ALWAYS** clear access to a hydrant by keeping the hydrant clear of vegetation and parked cars.

Contact Bass Coast Shire 1300 226 278 for missing marker post, missing hydrant or blue reflector.

Contact Westernport Water on 1300 720 711 for leaking hydrant or burst water main.

Meeting with BCSC CEO

The Rhyll Community Association met with the BCSC CEO Greg Box last week in regards to a couple of matters. The primary one being the Rhyll Hall ramp removal.

We have made our position clear and demonstrated the difficulty in the car park for any disabled cars to use the parking spot when other cars are in the parking area.

We have also pointed out the problems with the ramp for larger wheelchairs (and elderly) and indicated how much easier it would be for disabled and elderly to use our suggested car parks off Lock Road.

At the moment, the BCSC are sticking to their position that disabled parking cannot be isolated from general parking areas, regardless of whether additional general car parks are alongside the disabled.

We will not give in!! There's an election coming up.
