Financial Report:

Trees on the foreshore: Motion for RCA subcommittee to be formed to liaise with council and police regarding the recurrent vandalism of recently planted trees. Moved J Kiley. Seconded: G Mahony. Carried. **ACTION: Photos of damaged trees and chlorine tablets to be taken.** Jim to donate wire for guards.

Jetty Shed Carpark: Master Plan to be consulted and followed up with Council.

Heritage signage at the Jetty Shed: J Jansson's historical records have been assembled into a cohesive record of Rhyll from its use by the First Nations people to European settlement and subsequent development.

Other Business:

Brian Arnold suggests that RCA build a Rotunda at the end of Walton on the southern foreshore reserve which is managed by council. J Lawrence will follow up on costs and design from the PI Cemetery Trust who have just installed one. **ACTION: Judy to circulate the information so that discussion can take place at the 16 May Meeting.**

Improvements to the Hall and Park: AV wiring installed, anchor points for the roof to be sought. BCSC Sport & Rec. to replace Basketball hoop, backboard and pole. Heritage Fans and lighting to replace existing ones to be installed.

Reid St roadworks: Council is reviewing their Road Maintenance Policy. Their March meeting will consider a Draft Suppression Policy which includes a fixed cost per resident if 100% agree. Ongoing discussion continues with residents.

New Dog signs to be installed and adjustment made to the Lock Rd sign by David and Bill.
